- Entries of participants should be in .jpg/ .jpeg/ .png/ .pdf/ .doc./ .docx formats
- Submission of entries should follow the subject-line: "NAME OF THE EVENT_NAME OF THE PARTICIPANT" (Full name first name followed by surname) (e.g. DIGITAL POSTER_ ABC XYZ)
- Judge's decision will be final.
- All the participants will be acknowledged with participation certificates. Winners of each competition/event (category-wise) will be acknowledged with winner's certificates on 03rd November, 2022.
- Selected works of the participants and name of the winners will be displayed in the University website.
